All costs will be deducted from the income generated before the profit is shared.

Residential Development Design Guide Supplementary Planning Document (Cont.)	 Pedestrian routes off culs-de-sac will be acceptable where the public space that the route passes through is designed into the overall layout of the development such that it feels safe and comprises an unambiguous public route that is short, straight/direct and overlooked by housing (including where the cul-de-sac or the short, direct overlooked pedestrian route opens into parkland or play areas etc). Culs-de-sac, with pedestrian routes off them as described above (whether comprising a non-car link between one cul-de-sac and a nother, or a non-car link between one cul-de-sac and a through street) will be encouraged where they create a shorter route to a destination by foot/cycle than by car. Other forms of pedestrian route out of culs-de-sac that do not meet the above criteria will not be acceptable, in the interest of crime prevention.
