

CALL-IN NOTICE

CALL IN OF DECISION TAKEN 30 NOVEMBER 2021 (ADOPTION OF THE SOUTH EAST MILTON KEYNES SUPPLEMENTARY PLANNING DOCUMENT)

Bow Brickhill Parish Council, and Councillors D Hopkins and V Hopkins requested that the decision in connection with the above subject was reviewed (called-in).

After mediation, both parties withdrew their call-in(s), subject to the following undertakings by Councillor Marland (Leader of the Council):

1. That the Leader request that an additional Cabinet appointment of observer to the EWR Consortium Strategic Board be made and that in the event this is agreed, the appointment be David Hopkins.
2. That the Leader confirms by way of a statement, that he will write to the EWR Rail Company urging them to be more transparent in their decision making and urging them to bring forward their next phase of the Statutory Consultation in a timely manner to inform planning applications for SEMK.
3. That the Leader reveals, (for the cause of transparency), as much information on the progress being made in terms of the joint working between MKC and EWR as he considers prudent (given the NDA prohibits disclosure of financially confidential information in particular) via a monthly published News Report to 'stakeholders' from the Cabinet Member for Strategic Planning.
4. That an additional paragraph be inserted into the SEMK SPD that makes it clear that any change of location shown in the SPD for Woburn Sands Railway Station is indicative only and in no way provides the EWR Company with the opportunity to maintain that this is MKC's final position and therefore should not be open to further debate in the upcoming EWR Statutory Consultation.
5. That all Highways Data that officers maintain exists and upon which the decision to adopt the SEMK SPD was based, be published.
6. That the delegated decision to adopt the South East Milton Keynes supplementary planning document be re-taken on Tuesday 11 January 2022.
7. That the Leader and senior council officers meet with the Chair of Bow Brickhill Parish Council w/c 4 January to discuss the decision, and in particular:
 - a) The impact on traffic on Bow Brickhill and any available options for traffic calming.
 - b) The management of the volume of traffic using Bow Brickhill, during any closure of the v10 for construction works.
