Good morning Simon

I am the Police Licensing Officer for Milton Keynes and have been sent the application for the above premises as part of the consultation process.

I have reviewed the application and discussed it with the Neighbourhood Team Sergeant, and whilst the application has been well thought through, we do have some concerns that the licensing objectives may not be being adequately promoted, in particular to prevention of crime and disorder and prevention of public nuisance in relation to some specific local issues which your client may not be fully aware of.

In short there is an ongoing issue with street drinkers in and around the Queensway area. Last year it was the second highest location for reports of ASB connected to street drinking across Milton Keynes. Having said this, we are of the opinion that our concerns could be alleviated with some conditions added to your client's operating schedule to ensure the granting of their licence application does not negatively impact the ongoing local issues.

The conditions we propose are as follows:

1. ***Alcohol shall only be sold or supplied as an accompaniment to food served from the premises.***
2. ***The final time for ordering alcohol for consumption on the premises will 30 minutes before closure.***
3. ***All alcohol sold or supplied for consumption off the premises shall be in sealed containers.***

If you could speak with your client and take his instruction as to whether or not he is in agreement to the above conditions and confirm to both myself and David (cc'd into this email)?
